How to track your minutes:

## Family Readers:



Use the provided sticker sheets



Each sticker equals 20 minutes



When your sheet fills up or you run out of stickers ask for more at front desk

## Independent Readers



Use the lined sheets by writing down the book title and how long you read for

How to Check-in:



Check-in days are on the same day as the Tuesday program dates: July 11th, 18th, 25th, Aug 1st



Receive one raffle ticket for each hour of reading



Raffle tickets are to be filled out with name and phone number and entered into one of the prize bins



Drawing occurs at the conclusion of the Summer Reading Program, winners will be notified by phone



Small prizes are awarded at each check-in stage



**To be eligible to receive the grand prize of a 3D printed fidget spinner, a reader MUST complete all FOUR check-ins**
